# 1. Welcome and apologies

### 2. CLG to Society

MB shared the **4 points** raised by Richard Goldsbrough of CIBSE to progress the Business plan needed for the transition to Society of Vertical Transportation (SVT).

a. That there is a sufficient demand for a Society from individuals and organisations in the sector

AS: queried membership fees required.

CL: to be part of SVT candidates must be paying members of CIBSE in one of the following categories (using 2022 data). Whether SVT will charge the candidates to be members is down to the SVT's discretion.

b. That there is a sufficient set of volunteers involved to ensure the Society has adequate resource to function

RP, AS and CL raised concerns with requiring more volunteer commitment. CL: suggest that we need to attract the friends and colleagues of the industry to join us and also consider how we can set up a SVT-YEN.

c. That the Society has clear membership grades with supporting competencies and a rigorous assessment model

DC: To use the Postnominals LCIBSE, ACIBSE and MCIBSE, the candidate must fulfil the qualifications required. The process (to invigilating this) will need to be created.

MB: Richard Goldsbrough suggested SVT applicants submit CV detailing experience and evidence of up to date CPD records. Also set criteria for each grade of membership. Eg

Member SVT – has held a senior Lifts role for 10 years. Associate SVT – has worked in Lifts for min 2 years. Affiliate SVT – open to anyone who has an interest in the Society but don't get any professional designation.

RP: that will need commitment from the Executive members. MB: MB, PP, DC and JC are happy to be on the panel reviewing.

d. That the Society has a clear technical and CPD plan to support its members and progress the technical area covered by the Society

CL: we are already doing this every year.
